2013-6 Resolution on State Fair Investment

Passed June 9, 2013

Whereas, the State Ag and Rural Leaders, (SARL) is comprised of agriculture and rural leaders of state and provincial legislative bodies from the US and

Canada; and

Whereas, our global population is projected to reach nine billion people by 2050 and

the non-agriculture population has little to no understanding of the complexities involved in sustaining a viable agriculture system; and

Whereas, the potential negative impact of an uninformed population on United

States, Canadian, and global food, fiber, and renewable fuel production is

great; and

Whereas, an informed citizenry will create win-win policies and solutions that insure

the long-term sustainability of agriculture, natural resources, and quality

of life across the United States and Canada; and

Whereas, state, county, provincial, and regional non-profit, government and quasi-

government agriculture fairs have been providing education to the agriculture community since the 1700s in the U.S. and Canada by showcasing livestock, crop and horticulture production by identifying superior genes, and by demonstrating best practices, innovations, and

cutting edge technologies; and

Whereas, state, county, provincial and regional fairs provide one of the most

important opportunities for 4-H, FFA and other youth groups to receive

recognition and positive reinforcement for their accomplishments; and

Whereas, now over 150 million people primarily from urban and suburban areas,

two or three generations removed from farms, visit fairs in the U.S. and Canada annually to see farm animals, learn about agriculture and be

entertained by family oriented entertainment activities; and

Whereas, fairs have now shifted much of their focus, programming, and showcasing

to educate urban and suburban visitors about farming, food security, natural resources, and the production, distribution, marketing, and

consumption of agriculture products; now therefore be it

Resolved, that State Agricultural and Rural Leaders (SARL) supports investment in

the infrastructure and programming of state, county, provincial, and regional agriculture fairs by the states and provinces; and be it further

Resolved, that this resolution be submitted to state and federal officials as it is

deemed necessary.
