

## 2014 Legislative Agriculture Chairs Summit

## **Resolution Encouraging Efforts to Increase Pollinators**

Whereas, the State Ag and Rural Leaders, (SARL) is comprised of agriculture and

rural leaders of state and provincial legislative bodies from the US and

Canada; and

Whereas, bees and bats, have a critically important role in agriculture and

horticulture and help to produce a healthy, abundant and affordable food

and fiber supply and sustain ecosystem health; and

**Whereas**, U.S. Department of Agriculture says bee pollination is responsible for

more than \$15 billion in increased crop value each year and that bats serve as both pollinators and insect predators with a value of more than

\$22 billion a year to agriculture; and

**Whereas,** possible declines in the health, distribution and population of bees and

bats pose what could be a significant threat to global food supplies; and

**Whereas,** there is an urgent need for research to further identify causes and

solutions to the loss of both bee and bat populations; now therefore be it

**Resolved,** State Agriculture and Rural Leaders supports research on causes and

practical solutions, coordinated among states, governments, academia,

growers, and industry; and be it further

**Resolved,** that states, provinces and federal governments consider policies to

encourage an increase in bee and bat friendly habitat and forage areas;

and be it further

**Resolved,** that this resolution be submitted to appropriate state and federal

officials.
